We are on the cusp of very exciting times at our Club, and we are determined that a few will not spoil enjoyment of the majority. Nor do we intend to stand by and let unacceptable behaviour jeopardise our merger negotations.

So please, at all times but particularly when you are representing our Club, refrain from any anti-social behaviour and be aware of those around you.

These advices should be interpreted as a General Warning to all members. No further warnings will be issued.

Breaches will be dealt with swiftly.
